During the 1920s, filling station designs often replicated house styles so as not to detract from the residential character of the neighborhood. This vernacular gabled-ell style building shows heavy influence from the Folk Victorian houses of the period. A former filling station, this building features a pressed tin ceiling painted light blue to discourage mosquitos from feasting on guests. Now employed as a restaurant and distillery, the former service bays are seeing new life as seating areas for special events.
